PG403 was presented with a new amendment by Delegate Summers, the sponsor. Amendment passed by voice vote.

PG-403-12 passed Favorably With Amendments in an 18-0 vote.

PG 410 was presented. An amendment passed by voice vote.

PG-410-12 passed Favorably With Amendments in a 16 – 0 vote, with Dels. Gaines and Proctor abstaining.

PG 301 was reported with an amendment that exempts National Harbor. Members debated before deciding to **Special Order PG 301 for One Week.**

4. Consideration of Late-Filed Bills

Members were given copies of PG/MC-113, a late submission bill from Montgomery County.

Vice Chair Vaughn announced that the bill would be included with another at the public hearing to be held Monday, Feb. 20 at a location to be determined in the county.

Delegate Doyle Niemann made a motion for the delegation to accept and consider any bill in hand with the delegation as of Feb 13. Members debated the motion and whether it was appropriate to accept late-filed bills.

Members voted on 9-9 on the motion, which did not gain the necessary 2/3rds majority required to accept late legislative proposals.
