- 1. Meeting convened.**
- 2. Subcommittee Reports:**
  - A) County Affairs (Delegate Ross, Committee Chair)**

Chair Ross presented PG 418 (Payment in Lieu of Taxes program), which was passed favorably with amendments by the subcommittee

**Members voted unanimously 19-0 in favor of the amended bill.**

Chair Ross next presented PG 402 (Enable fee for disposable bags), which failed to gain a constitutional majority three times in subcommittee. He moved for an unfavorable report on the bill.

Del. Niemann then made a motion to report the bill as favorable.

**Members voted 12-9 for a favorable report on PG 402.**

**B) MNCPPC (Delegate Walker, Chair)**

Chair Walker presented PGMC 109 (Escrow – Traffic Impact Fees) with an amendment supported by the subcommittee. The amendment was accepted by voice vote without objection.

**Members voted 15-2 favorably with an amendment for PGMC 109. Delegates Braveboy and Howard passed.**

**C) WSSC (Delegate Pena-Melnyk, Chair)**

Chair Pena-Melnyk presented PGMC 110 (WSSC – High Performance Buildings), with a favorable recommendation.

**Members voted unanimously 18-0 to make a favorable report.**

Chair Pena-Melnyk next introduced PGMC 105 (WSSC - Residential Rental Property – Delinquency – Receiver), which was withdrawn by the sponsor.

**Member voted by voice to send an unfavorable report to the standing committee.**

3. Presentation by Prince George’s County Councilwoman Ingrid Turner, President of the Maryland Association of Counties.
4. Chair Griffith called for the delegation to hold an open dialogue, where the delegation discussed Transportation funding and the budget.
