II. Subcommittee Reports /Bills For Discussion:

1. Bi-County Affairs: Delegate Joseline Pena-Melnyk, chair

- **MC/PG 103 – WSSC – System Development Charge, Exemptions**

Delegation members present voted unanimously to give a favorable recommendation to MC/PG 103-13.

- **MC/PG 106: WSSC Supplemental Salary**

Delegation special ordered bill for one week by voice vote

2. Law Enforcement & State-Appointed Boards: Delegate Kriselda Valderrama, chair

- **PG 318 Alcoholic Beverages - Hours of Sale for Golf Course Licenses**

Members voted 19-0 to accept PG 318 as a late bill.

3. County Affairs: Delegate Jay Walker, chair

- **PG 415 – Task Force to Study Locating Businesses in Prince George’s County**

Delegate Walker presented PG 415, which had a Favorable report from the subcommittee. Received a Favorable report from the 20 members present.

- **PG 416 – Task Force to Study Energy Generation**

Delegate Walker presented PG 416, which had a Favorable report from the subcommittee. Received a Favorable vote unanimously by the 19 members present.

- **PG 417 - Prince George’s County Public Schools - Certificated Professional Individuals - Termination of Employment**
