- **PG 305-14** - Juvenile Court and School Safety Workgroup - Continuation, Membership, Duties **(FWA)**

Unanimous Vote by Members Present -- Passed Favorable with Amendments

### 3. **County Affairs:** Delegate Jay Walker, Chair

- **PG 403-14** - University of Maryland College Park Bus Service - Motor Vehicle Permit Exception - Removal of Sunset **(FAV)**

Passed FAV in a 16 – 1 vote

- **PG 404-14** - City of College Park Employees - Participation in the Employees' Pension System **(FAV)**

Held one week at request of Delegate Griffith
