A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George’s County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class B–ECF/DS Beer, Wine,**  
3 **and Liquor License**

4 **PG 306–19**

5 FOR the purpose of expanding the scope of the Class B–ECF/DS beer, wine, and liquor  
6 license to authorize certain individuals to hold certain events at the Prince George’s  
7 Community College Main Campus; specifying that the Board of License  
8 Commissioners for Prince George’s County may issue a Class B–ECF/DS license for  
9 use only on the University of Maryland, College Park Campus or the Prince George’s  
10 Community College Main Campus; authorizing a license holder to sell beer, wine,  
11 and liquor for on–premises consumption from multiple designated outlets on the  
12 Prince George’s Community College Main Campus only under certain circumstances;  
13 requiring profits from the sale of alcoholic beverages sold under the license to be  
14 deposited in a certain fund; requiring the Prince George’s Community College Main  
15 Campus to report to the Prince George’s County Board of License Commissioners at  
16 least a certain number of days before a certain catered function; and generally  
17 relating to a Class B–ECF/DS beer, wine, and liquor license in Prince George’s  
18 County.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
10 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

11 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

12 26–102.

13 This title applies only in Prince George’s County.

14 26–1009.

15 (a) There is a Class B–ECF/DS (Education Conference Facility/Dining Service)  
16 beer, wine, and liquor license.

17 (b) The Board may issue the license to an individual who is:

18 (1) (I) authorized by the University of Maryland, College Park Campus  
19 to:

20 [(i)] 1. act on its behalf under the license; and

21 [(ii)] 2. be subject to the penalties, conditions, and restrictions  
22 under this title; and

23 [(2)] (II) a resident and registered voter of the county; OR

24 (2) (I) AUTHORIZED BY THE PRINCE GEORGE’S COMMUNITY  
25 COLLEGE MAIN CAMPUS TO:

1                                   **1.     ACT ON ITS BEHALF UNDER THE LICENSE; AND**

2                                   **2.     BE SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES, CONDITIONS, AND**  
3 **RESTRICTIONS UNDER THIS TITLE; AND**

4                                   **(II)   A RESIDENT AND REGISTERED VOTER OF THE COUNTY.**

5                   **(C)   THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A LICENSE FOR USE ONLY ON THE UNIVERSITY**  
6 **OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK CAMPUS OR THE PRINCE GEORGE’S COMMUNITY**  
7 **COLLEGE MAIN CAMPUS.**

8                   **[(c)] (D)**   (1)   The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and  
9 liquor for on–premises consumption from multiple designated outlets on:

10                                   **(I)**   the University’s campus only at University–related functions  
11 catered by the Department of Dining Services; **OR**

12                                   **(II)   THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE’S CAMPUS ONLY AT**  
13 **COMMUNITY COLLEGE–RELATED FUNCTIONS CATERED BY THE PRINCE GEORGE’S**  
14 **COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAIN CAMPUS.**

15                                   (2)   Beer, wine, and liquor purchased at a designated outlet are to be  
16 consumed in the confines of that outlet and may not be transported to another outlet.

17                   **[(d)] (E)**   All profits from the retail sale of beer, wine, and liquor shall be  
18 deposited in:

19                                   **(1)**   the Dining Services Income Fund of the University of Maryland; **OR**

20                                   **(2)**   **A DESIGNATED AUXILIARY SERVICES FUND OF THE PRINCE**  
21 **GEORGE’S COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAIN CAMPUS.**

22                   **[(e)] (F)**   The Board:

23                                   (1)   may regulate the manner in which beer, wine, and liquor are dispensed  
24 under the license;

1                   (2)     before issuing the license, shall designate the exact campus locations  
2 for the outlets for the sale of beer, wine, and liquor;

3                   (3)     shall maintain a map and description of the designated outlets for  
4 verification on the renewal of the license; and

5                   (4)     shall require the Department of Dining Services of the University of  
6 Maryland, College Park Campus **OR THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COMMUNITY COLLEGE**  
7 **MAIN CAMPUS** to report to the Board at least 5 days before a University-related **OR A**  
8 **COMMUNITY COLLEGE-RELATED** catered function at which beer, wine, or liquor is  
9 intended to be sold or served.

10            **[(f)] (G)**     The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and  
11 days as set out for a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license under § 26–2004 of this title.

12            **[(g)] (H)**     The annual license fee is \$8,275.

13            SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
14 1, 2019.
